

# PKG 101 - A Parking Guide For Adjunct Faculty

## *What You Need to Know Before Coming to Campus*



- Anyone who parks on the UMBC campus between the hours of 8 AM and 4 PM must have an active parking permit.

- If you are parking after 4:00 PM, you can park in any legal space without a permit. Parking zones are not enforced after 4 PM. Standard traffic regulations such as no parking in accessible, service, and loading spots are enforced 24/7.

- All permits are virtual and are connected to your license plate. Before purchasing your initial permits, please submit the [PERMIT INFO - NEW HIRE FORM](#) to Parking Services.

- Daily permits are \$2 per day and can be purchased at [umbc.nupark.com/portal](http://umbc.nupark.com/portal) or at the Parking Services Offices. Daily permits are sold in packs of 5, 10, 15 or 30 and do not expire.

- Need to check how many permits you have remaining? Simply log-in to your Parking Account. In your account, under permits, you will see how many permits you have left. You will receive an e-mail when you are out of permits with a link to purchase more.

- Staff can use Visitor Parking for \$2.00 per hour. Pay stations accept Visa, MasterCard, and currency. Pay stations do not give change/refunds. **No Exceptions.** You may also use the Passport or Park Mobile Parking App.

- You may purchase a faculty parking permit for \$280/year (prorated throughout year). This is not cost efficient if you are on campus less than three days per week.
