


UMBC DoIT Desktop and AV Services

The <u>Desktop</u> and <u>Audio Visual Services</u> unit is led by <u>David Toothe</u>, Director. The unit provides desktop computer and audiovisual support to administrative and academic units throughout the University. The unit provides the following services:

- Manage the <u>audiovisual technology</u> present in all Registrar-controlled classrooms;
- Manage the operation, including software installation, of all registrar-controlled computer classrooms;
- Manage the software operation for all staff and faculty computers supporting day-to-day duties;
- Provide support for <u>virtual desktop software</u> to remotely access our computer lab software from home;
- Provide consulting support for development of active learning, hyflex, and synchronous lecture capture spaces on campus
- Design, engineer, install, and program much of the campus audiovisual technology.
- Oversee support for desktop video conferencing.

Visit your instructional spaces (in advance)

- In person, well in advance of the semester start
- Bring your laptop and connect to the AV system
 - HDMI video connection bring your adapter if needed!
 - Use the wireless network Visitor, Eduroam (preferred)
- Not all classrooms are the same
 - Traditional, lecture halls, active learning, hyflex, synchronous lecture capture
- All classrooms have:
 - Standard control interface, projector/display, speakers, HDMI laptop cable, instructions
- Try out the features you typically use:
 - Microphones, document cameras, DVD, special features for remote participants, etc.
- Classroom technology demos available by appointment
